Or why not cut out the shapes to make a pet

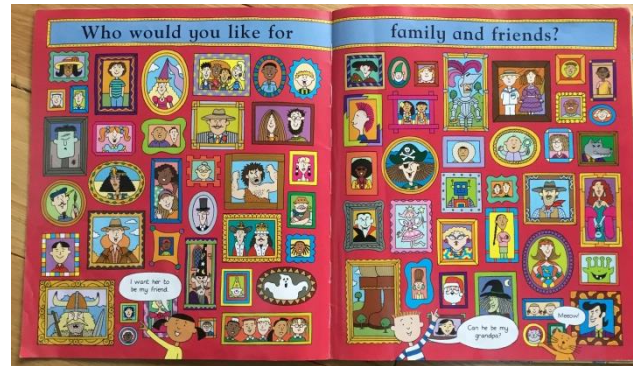
