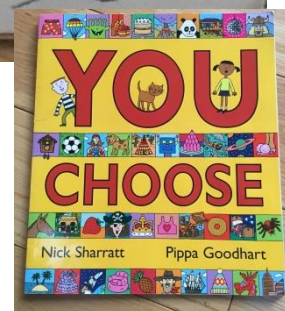


If you could go anywhere,

Where have you been on holiday? What did you enjoy? Was it hot or cold? Was it busy or quiet?

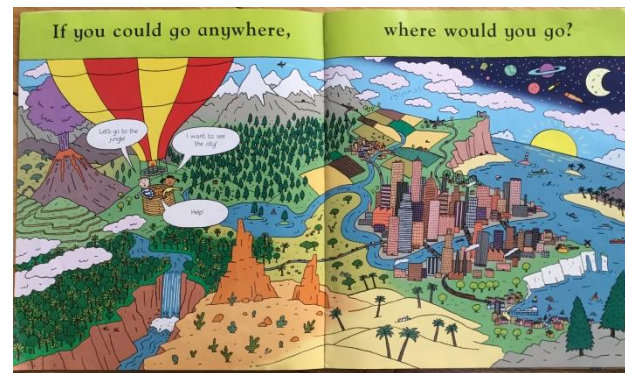
Maybe you can look at some photos from your holiday and tell someone about them.
